STATEMENT FROM SPBS

Statement regarding Silver/Silver Gene

After extensive research, it has become apparent that there are abnormalities within the pedigrees of Shetland ponies of the colour Silver or carriers of the Silver Gene.

The SPSBS (Mother Stud-Book Society) strongly advises its members/breeders and members/breeders of its Daughter Societies not to use ponies of the colour Silver or carriers of the Silver Gene within their breeding programs for registered pure-bred Shetland ponies.

Investigation and research into this is ongoing and may result in registered Shetland ponies of the colour Silver or Silver Gene being removed from all Stud Books for pure-bred Shetland ponies.

Marian & Roy Lusby imported Thorpeville Brodie 61NZ, Thorpeville Gidget 62NZ & Thorpeville Erika 63NZ and they were all registered in our stud book in July 1991.

Breeding under the North Close prefix, they bred:

- North Close Maggie (IID) 77NZ (IID Means Imported In Dam) (Sire Musketeer Of Wetherden (Imp UK)
- North Close Eliza (IID) 94NZ Sire Musketeer Of Wetherden (Imp UK)
- North Close McDhui 104NZ Sired one Stallion Shady Glade Kermit, but Kermit never left any progeny
- North Close Emma 117NZ
- North Close Bridget 118NZ
- North Close Lady Sue 160NZ
- North Close McDee 201NZ
- North Close Lucy 231NZ
- North Close Leo 274NZ

Gidget Progeny: North Close Maggie (IID) 77NZ, North Close McDhui 104NZ, Shady Glade Mariann 119NZ, North Close McDee 201NZ. Brodie Progeny: North Close Bridget 118NZ, Alanda Love-In-The-Mist 193NZ, Alanda Little Polly Flinders 243NZ.

Thorpeville Erika had quite an influence on the Stud Book and left the following progeny: North Close Eliza (IID) 94NZ, North Close Emma 117NZ, Cotswold Evita 250NZ, Alanda Maestro 382NZ (Stallion), Cotswold E.T. Commander 392NZ, Cotswold Emily 471NZ & Cotswold Eloise Sue 517NZ.

Her daughter North Close Eliza was dam of the Cotswold "E" line which included the very successful stallion Cotswold Royal Ensign 387NZ who has sired many champions. Cotswold Esmeralda 247NZ was the dam of Duncree Eclipse who won NZSPBS Sire of the Year. Cotswold Eclipse 125NZ, Cotswold Elliot 203NZ, Cotswold Esmeralda 247NZ, Cotswold Elton 284NZ, Cotswold Elation 359NZ & Cotswold Royal Ensign 378NZ.

North Close McDhui continued success as a gelding in the show ring and at promotional events in the Auckland region with Tiffany & Ann Storms until his passing.






